- TeLeo offers educational content to doctors, nurses, and psychosocial staff
- The agreement lasts four years and focuses on 12 Latin American countries
- So far, more than 3,500 professionals have benefited from this project

Barcelona, March 28, 2023. - The Foundation S – The Sanofi Collective has signed a collaboration agreement with Sant Joan de Déu Hospital from Barcelona related to TeLeo, an online training program in pediatric oncology implemented in Latin America.

The agreement, linked to the Foundation S "My Child Matters" program, has an expected duration of four years, and involves continuing the support of the Sanofi foundation for this initiative, which has been effective since the creation of the program in 2019.

Sant Joan de Déu Hospital, in partnership with the Leo Messi Foundation, the Sanofi Espoir Foundation (replaced in 2022 by Foundation S) and the Natali Flexer Foundation, participated in the development of the TeLeo program (Teleeducation in pediatric oncology in Latam). The program started in 2019 and launched TeLeo as a virtual platform in April 2021. Since the end of 2022, the program has been directly managed by Sant Joan de Déu Hospital.

This program, endorsed by scientific entities such as the Latin American Society of Pediatric Oncology (SLAOP), provides online educational content from global pediatric oncology experts for physicians, nurses, psychosocial staff, and associated specialties such as radiation therapy based in Latin American countries. In addition, the program enables interaction between healthcare professionals in those countries, allowing clinical dilemmas to be shared in the field and, therefore, providing more value to participants. So far, more than 3,500 professionals have been able to benefit from the program.
